

NOTICE TO EMPLOYERS
Municipal Elections Act, 1996

The 2006 Municipal Election will be held on a regular business day, Monday November 13, 2006.

In order that no one be deprived of their right to vote, employers are urged to cooperate in every way by making it possible for electors in their employ to vote.

Section 50 of the Municipal Elections Act, provides as follows:

ELECTOR'S ABSENCE FROM WORK

An elector whose hours of employment are such that he or she would not otherwise have three consecutive hours to vote on voting day is entitled to be absent from work for as long as is necessary to allow that amount of time. 1996, c. 32, Sched., s. 50 (1).

Employer's convenience

The absence shall be timed to suit the employer's convenience as much as possible. 1996, c. 32, Sched., s. 50 (2).

No deduction or penalty

The employer shall not make a deduction from the employee's pay or impose any other penalty for the absence from work. 1996, c. 32, Sched., s. 50 (3).
