

APPOINTMENT OF VOTING PROXY
Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (Sec. 44)

Section 44 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 states that a person who is entitled to be an elector in a local municipality may appoint another person who is also so entitled, as his or her voting proxy.

An elector may act on behalf of one other qualified elector who is not a relative, or one or more qualified electors who are relatives, using separate proxy forms. A relative means the parent, grandparent, child, grandchild, brother, sister, spouse or same-sex partner of the elector appointed.

Both the person appointing the proxy and the person who has been appointed as a voting proxy shall complete an application in the prescribed form and the appointed person shall present the application to the Clerk at the Clerk's Office in person.

The application may be presented at any time during regular business hours at the Clerk's Office - Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. or on November 4th (Advance Voting Day) from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Advanced Voting location will be City Hall, 500 George Street North.

Applications may also be presented at the Voting Places on Election Day (Monday, November 13, 2006) from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

A person who votes as a voting proxy is also entitled to vote in his or her own right. For further information, please contact the Clerk's Office at 742-7777, Ext. 1818.
